

# State of Oklahoma Pass-Through Entities Income Tax Payment Voucher

## Instructions

### What Is Form EF-PTE and Do You Have to Use It?

If you have already filed the return, send this voucher with the check or money order for any balance due on the 2024 Form 512-S or 514. Using Form EF-PTE allows us to process the payment more accurately and efficiently. We strongly encourage you to use Form EF-PTE, but there is no penalty if you do not.

### How to Prepare Your Payment

- Remit only one check or money order per voucher.
- Make the check or money order payable to the "Oklahoma Tax Commission." Do not send cash.
- Make sure the name of the entity appears on the check or money order.

### How to Send in the 2024 Tax Payment and Form EF-PTE

- Cut Form EF-PTE along the dotted line and submit the bottom portion along with payment.
- Do not staple or otherwise attach the payment to Form EF-PTE. Instead, just put them loose in the envelope.
- Do not include a copy of the income tax return. To use this form, the income tax return (either paper or electronic) should already be filed with the Oklahoma Tax Commission.
