By submitting this Letter of Intent (LOI) to the City of Philadelphia, you agree to meet our standards for software provider registration, tax preparation software, and substitute forms. If you do not meet the standards and requirements explained in this LOI or provide an incomplete form, we may deny your application or revoke your approved software provider status and reject all electronic and/or paper returns submitted using your products.

You must complete a separate LOI for each unique product your company offers.

Note: If you are a new Software Provider who has not filed city/state income tax returns with any city or state agencies, you must have passed assurance testing with the IRS. Attach documentation from the IRS demonstrating you have successfully tested with the IRS.

Important dates

The City of Philadelphia has important key dates to ensure we are ready for the filing season and taxpayers can file an accurate and timely tax return. Please note the following key dates:

- Complete and submit this LOI by September 30, 2022.
- Substitute forms approval must be completed by TBD.
- Assurance testing (ATS) begins mid-October, however, may be delays due to City of Philadelphia rolling out new system October 3rd.
- Last day we will accept initial E-File & paper tests are TBD.
- E-File & Paper tests must be completed and approved by TBD.

Testing and submissions

All e-file ATS and substitute forms/coupons tests submitted during the approval process must be created in, and originate from, the actual software.
