Qualifying Child Information

If you have more than three qualifying children, you only need to list three to get the maximum credit.

Table with 4 columns: Child's TIN, #1, #2, #3. Row 2 shows TIN information.

Table with 4 columns: Child's date of birth, #1, #2, #3. Row 3 shows date of birth information.

Table with 4 columns: Custodian's name, First Name, M. I., Last Name. Row 4 shows custodian name information.

Table with 4 columns: Custodian's address, Number, street and apartment, City, State, Zip code + 4. Row 5 shows custodian address information.

Table with 2 columns: Custodian's TIN, 1234567879. Row 6 shows custodian TIN information.

Table with 2 columns: Case or Docket number for, Name of government agency to which you make payments for. Rows 8-10 show case and agency information.

Table with 4 columns: Total payments made during 2017, #1, #2, #3. Row 13 shows total payments information.
