
Production Details

To ensure the programming is complete by NCDOR for any approved form, "Production Details" have been included on each Form Spec. The "Production Details" provide guidance for when the Developer can include the form in their software so this type of processing error can be avoided for the 2020 Approval Season.



Approved By Date: this date will be 30 days from the date a form is posted to the State Exchange System (SES). When a Software Developer (SD) has access to the forms folder, the SD will need to have the form approved by or before this date. If an SD does not have access to the forms folder at the time a form is posted, the 30-day approval time will begin when the SD received access to the forms folder. We allow each Developer to have 30 days from either access to the SES forms folder or the posting of the form to the SES to gain approval.

Form Period Date Effective: the first available period that is eligible to use the newly approved form.

For Filing Periods: the range of filing periods that are eligible to use the newly approved form.

Form Placed in Software: the first available date the newly approved form can be placed in software to avoid production errors.

Unchanged/Updated: the classification for the SD form available for reproduction. For unchanged forms, the alignment of the data/text, size/location of the barcode, placement of the barcode number and line geometry of the test samples submitted match the approved trained version. For updated forms, the alignment of the data/text, size/location of the barcode, placement of the barcode number and line geometry of the test samples submitted should match the SD Final or in some cases, the DOR Final posted on the SES.
