

D-407V AmendedAmended Estates and Trusts Payment Voucher

What Is Form D-407V Amended and Why Should the Estate or Trust Use It?

Form D-407V Amended is a payment voucher that a fiduciary of an estate or a trust must use if the fiduciary mails a paper check for payment of tax due when a fiduciary amends an estates and trusts income tax return, Form D-407.

Important: If the fiduciary eFiles the estate's or trust's amended return but elects not to pay the tax due using eFile software or if the fiduciary elects to file the estate's or trust's amended return by mail, the fiduciary must use this voucher.

Preparing and Sending the Estate's or Trust's Payment

- Make the check payable in U.S. dollars to the NC Department of Revenue. The Department will not accept a check unless it is drawn on a U.S. (domestic) bank and the funds are payable in U.S. dollars.
- Make sure the estate's or trust's name and address appear on the check.
- Make sure the check is signed.
- Enter the estate's or trust's tax year, FEIN, and daytime phone number on the check.
- Staple the check in the designated area located on the top left corner of the form and send the payment to the address listed below.

Do not separate the voucher from the rest of the form.
