This test case is of an individual Interest and Dividends Tax Return with interest, dividend, and federal tax exempt interest amounts carried over from the Federal Return (not included in test scenario). There are no distributions from other entities reported on Line 2. There are tax exempt amounts reported on Line 4. After exemptions, Net Taxable Income is \$49,928 resulting in tax of \$2,496 prior to application of payments in the amount of \$3,099.
